- 3.Incorporate movements- It is very difficult for preschoolers to sit at one place therefore incorporating some movements like dancing, musical moments, or some games etc is a good idea.
- 4. We try to Keep the session Interactive with humor also and voice modulation etc ..
- 5. Parent presentation and engagement is very important to keep the child focussed.
- 6. Show and tell- Online sessions give us a great glimpse into our child's personal life
- 7.We Use Props also to make the session interactive and informative. PreSchoolers pick things easily through visual learning.
- 9. Once a Week Activities, where Parents Keep Props Ready before the Start of the Class with Essentials and then Help us in Way Forward along with the Children are held for Nursery and Kinder Garten Classes
